Faith is fundamental to any ministry. **Without faith** nobody can **please God**.

By faith miracles and mighty deeds take place and the church is consolidated in the land. We use to say everything is possible with God. But, do we apply that faith in the practical aspects of life? If not, we should start doing it from now on.

#### **Faith Applied in Ministry**

Things to do while praying for individuals:

1. Instil faith in their minds through the word of God
2. Approach them with faith

Whenever Jesus healed the sick, He always did it with faith and mentioned the power of faith to them.

#### **Faith Applied in Personal Life**

Satan will not be able to stand before your faith. *Above all, taking the **shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench** all the fiery darts of the wicked (Ephesians 6:16).*

The resilience of our faith is that it has the power to quench all the **fiery darts** of the devil. If we believe that the devil cannot do anything to us, nothing bad will happen to us.

To overcome **the terror of night, the arrow that flies by day, the pestilence that stalks in the darkness and the plague that destroys at midday**, Jesus who has authority over all these lives inside us. Hence, no harm will overtake us and no disaster will come near our tent. We will **tread on the lion and the cobra and trample the great lion and the serpent**. But, nothing will

harm us. You should have this faith inside you. If you still dread the devil that is because you don't live in the reality of the word.

Our faith will grow only when we understand that we are vested with authority. We have already learnt about our authority in the previous chapters. We now have to just apply it in the personal spheres of life.

#### **What Can Faith Do?**

Faith can make, break, build, demolish, protect and heal, and do many more things as and when we ask. To apply our faith we just have to say what must happen in a person. God has given us the freedom and authority to decide that.

Hear more about faith and apply what you have heard in practical life. **Believe** that you have received whatever you have asked for. Walk your faith by behaving as though you have received all that you have prayed for.

Many of us act as the police person at the traffic junction who stands idle leaning against the post with crossed arms. However large or small all vehicles must stop if he flags them down. His uniform displays authority. Standing on the middle of the road, he has to signal the vehicles to stop while they are still running. He has to act with authority thinking the vehicles are bound to stop on his signal.

So, do not stand idle anymore. Act with the authority you have received through your faith. Be proactive - behave as you though have received whatever you have prayed for. That is what faith is. ■
